BENEFITS OF PROPOSED SERVICE

AC Webconnecting Holding BV as the operator of .cam, continuously tries to serve as many international markets as possible. Allowing speakers of the languages we want to add, to register domains in their own language regardless of their actual geographical location, allows them to have a better user experience and be more natural while using a domain in their native language.

We really think that the markets we want to address have the potential to increase the IDN adoption in general, since the vast majority of them are not so english savvy.

Many registry operators permit multiple language script registration in their TLDs and many more will join along the way.
